1. Complete a brief statement on the 2010 proposed Annual Budget and make comparison to the current year's adopted budget. Explain significant increases or decreases, if any.

The FY 2010 Budget expenses are down from the FY 2009 expenses by 2.4%. The reduction in expenses is the result of a reduction and stabilization of energy costs, decrease in chemical use and expense and the general impact of the present state of the economy.

2. Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on Anticipated Revenues, especially service charges and on the general purpose/component unit financial statements. Explain significant increases or decreases, if any.

Though energy related and chemical expenses saw a reduction in projected cost in FY 2010, however, the loss of revenue associated with the interest earnings and other miscellaneous incomes in 2009, coupled with a projection of lower flows to be received from the Authority participants in 2010, revenues are down by approximately \$1,000,000. Investment income/interest earnings are expected to only slightly improve in FY 2010. Because of the loss of revenue and previous budget deficiencies, it is necessary for the Authority to increase its rate by 5.9% to address the projected revenue shortfall. The Authority has also used \$479,100 in retained earnings to balance the budget.

3. Describe the state of the local/regional economy and how it may impact the proposed Annual Budget, including the planned Capital Budget/Program.

The growth of the local economy has continued to slow. The number of new and redevelopment projects being proposed or implemented has significantly reduced over past years. The Authority, however, continues to foresee an increase in the demand for sewer service within our Service Area due to redevelopment after the economy improves. In anticipation of future sewer use needs, the Authority has developed and continues to update our Capital Plan which interlocks with our Long-Term Financial Plan.

4. Describe the reasons for utilizing Unrestricted Net Assets in the proposed Annual Budget; i.e. rate stabilization, debt service reduction, to balance the budget, etc.

The FY 10 Budget is using \$479,100 of Retained Earnings to balance the FY 10 Budget for the reasons set forth in the answers to the above questions.

5. If the proposed Annual Budget contains an Accumulated Deficit either existing or anticipated, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:5A-12, then an explanation as to reasons for occurrence must be disclosed.

The Accumulated Deficit from FY 08 is being addressed and eliminated as part of the FY 2010 Budget.

- Yes. Each municipality or MUA/SA within the Authority service area is represented by two (2) representatives of that community on the Authority Board of Commissioners. The Authority Board of Commissioners participate in and approve all Capital Plans and Projects.
- 2. Has each capital project/project financing been developed from a specific capital improvements plan or report; does it include full lifecycle costs, and is it consistent with appropriate elements of Master Plans or other plans in the jurisdictions served by the Authority?
- All capital projects have been developed from specific plans or reports. Lifecycle costs have not been developed for all projects. Yes, the capital projects are consistent with the appropriate portion of master plans or other plans dealing with wastewater treatment.

Yes, through the year 2018.

When the Authority developed its Capital Plan it also developed a Long-Term Financial Plan that interlocks with the Capital Plan. Under the Financial Plan the Authority has scheduled and structured the new debt that it will be incurring for Capital Projects to coincide with the retiring of previous bonds that have reached their maturity. By using this approach the Authority's level of Debt Service supported by the Authority User Rate will remain stable since new debt payments will be replacing the old Debt Service payments. This will result in the Debt Service portion of the User Rate remaining stable.

5. Please indicate which capital projects/project financings are being undertaken in the Metropolitan or Suburban Planning Areas as defined in the State Development and Redevelopment Plan.

All capital projects being undertaken are contained in either Planning Areas 1 and 2 or in State Plan designated growth centers one of which is composed of portions of Bridgewater Township, the Borough of Raritan and the Borough of Somerville. The other center is located in the Borough of Manville.

6. Please indicate which capital projects/project financings are being undertaken within the boundary of a State Planning Commission-designated Center and/or Endorsed Plan and if the project was included in the Plan Implementation Agenda for that Center/Endorsed Plan?

The two (2) State Plan designated growth centers are within the Authority service area. The Outfall Relocation Project was not included in the State Plan implementation agenda or endorsed by the Plan, however, the State Plan and the Smart Growth proposals were considered where appropriate, and incorporated into the Authority's Capital Planning.
