

SOMERSET RARITAN VALLEY SEWERAGE AUTHORITY

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS & PROPOSAL PROFESSIONAL AIR QUALITY/AIR EMISSION MONITORING/ REGULATORY COMPLIANCE PERMITTING SERVICES

The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority (SRVSA) is issuing a Request for Qualifications & Proposal (RFQ/RFP) from engineering firms or engineers licensed to practice in the State of New Jersey to provide professional air quality/air emission monitoring/regulatory compliance permitting services to the SRVSA. The firm or engineer must provide advice and assistance for all environmental permitting and compliance issues related to air quality emissions, the applicant must have proven expertise and experience in all phases of operation, permitting, planning, sludge/ash management and disposal and other incineration/air emission engineering as needed for the SRVSA **from February 1, 2021 to February 7, 2022.**

Proposals are being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.

Proposals will be evaluated by SRVSA on the basis of the most advantageous, price and other factors considered. The evaluation will consider:

- a. Experience and reputation in the field;
- b. Knowledge of the SRVSA and the subject matter to be addressed under the contract;
- c. Availability to accommodate any required meetings of the agency;
- d. Designated professional and support staff and location of firm's offices;
- e. References in general;
- f. Compensation proposal; if used, please state what percent multiplier will be used for calculating billing to the SRVSA
- g. Knowledge of Federal Title V Air Emission Process and Regulations
- h. Other factors if demonstrated to be in the best interest of the SRVSA.

Selection of Air Quality Engineer shall be based solely on the SRVSA's evaluation of the submitted material and the criteria set forth in this document. The SRVSA reserves the right to negotiate the terms and conditions of the contract with the successful firm or firms to obtain the most advantageous outcome for the SRVSA.

Proposals (three copies) should be submitted in writing in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the Proposer and the words "Air Quality Services". Proposals shall be sent to the Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority, 50 Polhemus Lane, Bridgewater, NJ 08807 no later than **Tuesday, January 12, 2021 at 2:00 P.M.**, at which time all proposals shall be opened.
