

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF THE

TYREE ORGANIZATION LTD.

WHEREAS, The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority has an established Industrial Pretreatment Program to allow for and regulate the discharge of industrial effluent and/or groundwater via a permit program; and

WHEREAS, Tyree Organization Ltd. has requested that The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority terminate the Groundwater Discharge Permit #3AGW at the Getty Service Station, which is located at 176 West End Avenue in Somerville, due to the ceasing of activities at the said location. The facility had not pumped any groundwater to the SRVSA since January 2010 and does not foresee any pumping of remediated groundwater in the future. NJDEP has determined that the reports were in compliance with the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation, N.J.A.C. 7:26E and other applicable requirements; and

WHEREAS, written comments or a request that the SRVSA hold a non-adversarial public hearing on the proposed permit termination must be submitted in writing to the Executive Director by the close of the public comment period, which closes thirty calendar days after publication of the Public Notice. All persons, including the permittee, who believe that the SRVSA's decision to terminate permit is inappropriate, must raise all reasonable ascertainable arguments and factual grounds supporting their position, including all supporting material during the public comments period. There were no written comments and no requests for a non-adversarial Public Hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority that it hereby authorizes the termination of the Tyree Organization, Ltd. Groundwater Discharge Permit #3AGW at Getty Service Station No. 56263 due to the ceasing of pumping activities that would generate groundwater at the facility.



Getty Service Station #56263 was located at 176 West End Ave. in Somerville New Jersey. Remediated groundwater was discharged from this location to SRVSA in accordance with permit #3AGW.

Tyree Organization, Ltd. had notified the SRVSA their intention to terminate the permit#3AGW, which technically expired on July 31, 2010. The Getty Station has not pumped any groundwater to the SRVSA since January 2010 and does not foresee any pumping of remediated groundwater in the future. NJDEP has determined that the reports were in compliance with the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation, N.J.A.C. 7:26E and other applicable requirements.

Based upon these facts and representations, the SRVSA is now considering Permit #3A GW terminated by non-renewal.

WHEREAS, The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority has an established Industrial Pretreatment Program to allow for and regulate the discharge of industrial effluent and/or groundwater via a permit program; and

WHEREAS, The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority has determined that a Non-Domestic Wastewater Discharge Permit be issued to Voltaix, LLC, located at 197 Meister Avenue, Branchburg, NJ, and that this Permit will allow Voltaix, LLC to discharge wastewater from the manufacturing process which is generated at its facility; and

WHEREAS, the permit, if approved, will be effective for five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the owner of Voltaix, LLC has agreed to abide by all the rules and regulations of the Authority concerning the discharge of non-domestic wastewater to the Authority's system; and

WHEREAS, a thirty-day Public Comment Period was held to receive written comments or to request that the SRVSA hold a non-adversarial Public Hearing. No public comments or requests for a Public Hearing were received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority that it hereby authorize the issuance of a Non-Domestic Wastewater Discharge Permit to Voltaix, LLC, located at 197 Meister Avenue in Branchburg, New Jersey.



SUBJECT: ISSUE NON-DOMESTIC WASTEWATER DISCHARGE PERMIT
Voltaix, LLC.

Voltaix, LLC is located at 197 Meister Avenue, Branchburg. Voltaix produces specialty gases. Their operation requires substantial monitoring.

The facility requires substantial monitoring at the outfall to the sanitary sewer, and at the points of production. Due to past incidents, the outfall to the sanitary sewer will be monitored monthly for LEL and H₂S. The other two (2) sampling sites will be monitored quarterly. The permitted monthly average flow is 5,500 gallons per day.

The permit will regulate the wastewater discharge from the manufacturing process. The permit, if approved, will be effective for five years.

Comments received from Voltaix were address in the final draft permit.

No comments were received from either the public or Voltaix, LLC. during the Public Comment Period.

**RESOLUTION AWARDING THE BID TO
INSTALL CURED-IN-PLACE PIPE LINER IN

WHEREAS, The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority ("the Authority") has an existing 12-inch diameter ductile iron sewer pipe that runs from a manhole located in the driveway area just east of Incinerator No. 2 to Junction Chamber No. 2 which is adjacent and just upstream of Primary Clarifiers Nos. 3, 4 & 5; and

WHEREAS, this sewer collects sludge dewatering and domestic sewer discharges from the Incinerator No. 2 facility and also the sanitary discharge from the Somerset County Recycling Center; and

WHEREAS, the Authority maintenance staff had discovered that this sewer line has deteriorated and is in need of repair or replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Authority staff had determined that installing a cured-in-place pipe liner is the most cost effective solution to restoring the structural integrity and function of the existing sewer pipe; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A.: 40:11-1 et. seq., the Authority is required to seek public bids for any product or service costing in excess of \$17,500; and

WHEREAS, after publicly advertising the project two (2) bids were received on Friday, March 15. Based on a review of those bid documents, it has been determined by the Authority's Staff that SWERP, Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder to the public advertisement and is recommending that they be awarded the Project for a total amount of \$23,747.00.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority Board of Commissioners that it hereby authorizes the awarding of the bid to **INSTALL CURED-IN-PLACE PIPE LINER IN EXISTING 12 INCH SANITARY SEWER** to SWERP, Inc. in accordance with bid documents for a total bid price of \$23,747.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Authority's Board of Commissioners that the Executive Director is hereby directed, empowered and authorized to enter into the necessary contracts.

INSTALL CURED-IN-PLACE PIPE LINER IN EXISTING SANITARY SEWER

This project was publicly advertised, in accordance with the New Jersey Local Public Contract Law and the Authority's normal procedures, on Tuesday, March 5, 2013. Four (4) sets of project specifications were purchased.

Sealed bids were received on Friday, March 15, 2013 for the Installation of Approximately 320 Linear Feet of a Cured-in-Place Pipe Liner in an Existing Twelve Inch (12") Diameter Sanitary Sewer, from the following:

SWERP, Inc.	\$23,747.00
All State Power Vac, Inc.	\$35,000.00

This Sanitary Sewer is the equipment drain from Incinerator No. 2 that discharges recycled flow upstream of primary treatment. Over the course of time, this line has become deteriorated to the point of failure. Our review of the available options indicated a cured-in-place pipe liner was the preferred alternative.

SWERP, Inc. provided the lowest bid proposal for this project, at a Total Bid Price of \$23,747.00. Therefore, I recommend that the bid be awarded to SWERP, Inc.



WHEREAS, an application has been received from the Borough of Somerville for the construction of approximately 68 lineal feet of 24" diameter PVC sanitary sewer main, which would discharge directly to the Raritan River during periods of excessive wet weather, and would alleviate the SSO condition that presently exists at Meter Chamber No. 4 (MC-4); and

WHEREAS, all wastewater that does not pass through this discharge point to the Raritan River will be received and treated at and by the facilities of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority, and

WHEREAS, this project is located within the Authority's Storm Control Pumping Station yard located off of Southside Avenue in Bridgewater Township, as shown on plans entitled (4 sheets):

"Meter Chamber #4 Bypass Piping and Manhole Improvements", Somerville Borough, Somerset County, New Jersey, prepared by Cole & Associates, LLC, dated March, 2013 and no revisions; and

WHEREAS, said application has been reviewed for conformance with the applicable wastewater management plans and documents and available permitted design treatment capacity, only, and is recommended for approval by, Ronald S. Anastasio, P.E., the Authority Engineer;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SOMERSET RARITAN VALLEY SEWERAGE AUTHORITY that it hereby consents to the construction of the above stated project, such consent being in accordance with the provisions of R.S.40:14A-29; and

Borough of Somerville Proposed Temporary Bypass
Treatment Works Approval

As the Board is aware, the solution to the Somerville Sanitary Sewer Overflow issue is complex and has many steps and contingencies associated with it. One of the initial steps is for the Borough of Somerville to construct of a temporary bypass to relieve the surcharging within the Borough's 27-inch trunk sewer and to relocate any future sanitary sewer overflows from the baseball diamond and park area along Peter's Brook to directly into the Raritan River. This bypass, which shall be owned and operated by the Borough, is proposed to be constructed just upstream of Meter Chamber #4 on Authority property at the Storm Control Pumping Station yard. While the proposed bypass is an unconventional type of construction, the NJDEP has decided that as part of their approval process the Borough shall obtain a Treatment Works Approval (TWA) for the proposed bypass, which is what is commonly known to the Board as a "sewer extension approval".

The proposed bypass consists of the installation of 68 lineal feet of 24-inch PVC pipe connected to the second manhole upstream from Meter Chamber #4 along the Borough's existing 27-inch trunk sewer. The proposed bypass will connect to this manhole near its top just below the ground surface, in order to allow the surcharged flow to exit the trunk sewer, while flow generated by Somerville can still pass through the bottom of the manhole to be conveyed to the Authority's interceptor. The proposed bypass will terminate at the northern bank of the Raritan River. The Borough will fund the construction of the bypass, as well as be responsible for all maintenance and operation duties. Once NJDEP has approved this project and issued a TWA permit, it will be necessary for the Authority to grant the Borough a temporary easement for the construction and maintenance access of the bypass.
