SUBJECT: New Discharge Permit for Amneal Pharmaceuticals, LLC (19 Readington Road)

Amneal Pharmaceuticals, LLC (19 Readington Road) has applied to the Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority (SRVSA) for a Non-Domestic Wastewater Discharge Permit. Amneal Pharmaceuticals, LLC is located at 19 Readington Road in Branchburg, New Jersey. The permit will allow them to discharge wastewater generated at the facility from the manufacturing of liquid dosage pharmaceuticals. If approved, the permit will be effective for five years.

Amneal Pharmaceuticals, LLC (19 Readington Rd) is regulated as a Categorical Industrial User under the Pharmaceutical Manufacturing Point Source - Mixing/Compounding and Formulation Subcategory, and is subject to 40 CFR 439.47 Pretreatment Standards for New Sources (PSNS). The Combined Wastestream Formulas has been applied to the 40 CFR 439.47 discharge limits due to account for dilution of the categorical flow.

Public notice regarding this permit renewal was issued on May 11, 2022. No comments from either the public or Amneal Pharmaceuticals, LLC (19 Readington Rd) were received during the Public Comment Period, which closed on June 9, 2022.

**SEWER EXTENSION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, an application has been received from Bridgewater Township for construction of a sewer collection system and a sewer connection to the appropriate Bridgewater Township line or lines to allow the discharge of sewage to be received and treated at and by the facilities of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority; and

WHEREAS, such sewer connection has been calculated to discharge a flow of 3,170 gallons per day from wight (8) proposed single family dwellings; and

WHEREAS, the project is located at Chimney Rock Road near the intersection with Fieldstone Road in Bridgewater Township and includes the construction of 615 linear feet of 8-inch PVC gravity sewer as shown on plans entitled (six sheets):

Preliminary Site Plan & Variance Plan, Cottages at Chimney Rock A Condominium, Block 802, Lot 131, Bridgewater Township, Somerset County, New Jersey, prepared by David A. Stires Associates, LLC., dated September 17, 2021, last revised May 16, 2022; and

WHEREAS, due to New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's strict limits on chlorination byproducts, the flow generated from this application only includes domestic sewage and does not include the acceptance of backwash and drain down discharges from any proposed swimming pools; and

WHEREAS, said application has been reviewed for conformance with the applicable wastewater management plans and documents and available permitted design treatment capacity, only, and is recommended for approval by, Sherwin Ulep, P.E., C.M.E., the Authority Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority sewer connection fee for this application shall be reviewed and calculated in accordance with current Authority connection fee policy prior to obtaining any building permits, and where each dwelling unit will be charged a minimum of one (1) EDU regardless of size;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SOMERSET RARITAN VALLEY SEWERAGE AUTHORITY that it hereby consents to the construction of the above stated collection and conveyance systems, such consent being in accordance with the provisions of R.S.40:14A-29; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority does hereby approve the Application of Bridgewater Township to connect to the Bridgewater Township collection system and to deliver sewage to the facilities of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority, subject to further approval of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this approval is not, nor shall it be construed to be, an allocation or guarantee of future capacity, and, further, that the connection fee or fees in effect at the time such connection is to be made shall be paid to the Authority in accordance with the Authority's regulations pertaining thereto and the terms of a Connection Fee Agreement entered into by and between the Applicant and the Authority on or before the date of adoption of this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this consent and approval will terminate if Applicant fails to complete construction of said collection facilities and to make connection thereof and commence delivery of sewage to the facilities of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority within two (2) years of the date hereof; and the Department of Environmental Protection is hereby notified that all time extension requests of this consent and approval must be approved by the Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director of the Authority is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Department of Environmental Protection and Bridgewater Township and the said Township is hereby directed to immediately notify the Authority when it receives notice and a request for the herein above project to be connected to the municipal sewer system.

This application is for the approval of the construction of a sewer extension that will serve eight (8) proposed single family dwellings and a clubhouse. The project is located at Chimney Rock Road near the intersection with Fieldstone Road in Bridgewater Township and includes the construction of 615 linear feet of 8-inch PVC gravity sewer. The project is designed to convey an average total flow of 3,170 gallons per day (gpd) as calculated below:

- 8 Single-Family Dwellings (300 gpd/dwelling) – 2,400 gpd
- 22 Person Capacity Clubhouse (35 gpd/dwelling) – 770 gpd

This application is in compliance with applicable wastewater management plans and documents and there is currently sufficient treatment capacity for the proposed contributory flow.

The developer/applicant has signed an Agreement with the Authority whereby the developer/applicant agrees to pay the Connection Fee to the Authority prior to applying for the necessary construction/ plumbing permits. This application is hereby recommended for approval.

**RESOLUTION AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT
PLANT SWITCHGEAR INSPECTION, SERVICE AND TESTING
CONTRACT B-22-2**

WHEREAS, The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority staff have determined that it is in the Authority's best interest to contract out the inspection, service and testing of the plant's electrical switchgear system; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contract Law, N.J.S.A.: 40:11-1 et. seq., requires that all public purchasing in excess of \$44,000 must be publicly advertised and bids awarded; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, June 17, 2022, The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority (the "Authority") received and publicly opened bids for **WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT SWITCHGEAR INSPECTION, SERVICE AND TESTING** for a 90-day period beyond the issuance of the Notice to Proceed; and

WHEREAS, although two (2) sets of contract specifications were sold, only one bid was received as described in the attached memo, and in a review of that bid, the Authority's staff have determined the bidding documents are in order, and the Authority staff recommends that the low bidder, M&L Power Systems, Inc., be awarded the contract for the **PLANT SWITCHGEAR INSPECTION, SERVICE AND TESTING** for a total bid price of \$239,800.00, which includes a \$40,000 allowance for switchgear repair, as needed;

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority has certified in writing the availability of funds for the purposes set forth in this Resolution, and the cost is provided for in the duly adopted budget of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority, Operating Budget line item Outside Services Electrical Repair – 01-400-6414; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority that it hereby awards the contract to Allied Control Services, Inc. for **PLANT SWITCHGEAR INSPECTION, SERVICE AND TESTING** for a total bid price of \$239,800.00, for a 90-day time period after the issuance of the Notice to Proceed, with funding for this work being provided from the Authority's FY 2022 Operating Budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority reserves the right to waive any and all non-material defects as found within the bid documents and the Authority's Board of Commissioners hereby waive any and all non-material defects and the Authority's Board of Commissioners hereby direct, empower and authorize the Executive Director to enter into the necessary contracts.



RE: CONTRACT AWARD FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
SWITCHGEAR INSPECTION, SERVICE AND TESTING

Like past budgets, the FY2022 budget includes funding for the switchgear inspection, service and testing. The frequency of this work is every two years. The last time this was awarded in February 2020, the service, testing and inspection (with no repairs) was performed at a cost of \$89,800. During that contract, this work was combined with general electrical services work within the facility. Based on that experience, we now prefer to leave the switchgear service contract separate from any general electrical work. The total value of that contract from 2020 was \$346,900.

Back in mid-May, we publicly advertised for the plant switchgear work. We have sold two (2) sets of contract documents but have only received one (1) bid for this contract on June 17th. We have received one bid from M & L Power Systems in the amount of \$239,800. This cost includes a \$40,000 allowance for repair items not included in the base contract. This specification includes a wide range of a number of repair items that will restore the overall condition of the switchgear system. We estimate that the base electrical testing portion of this work is probably worth around \$110,000 - \$115,000, and with the \$40,000 allowance, the remaining cost is attributed to these included repair items.

M&L Power Systems, Inc. has performed the switchgear maintenance at the Authority for many years and has always provided reliable service.

I recommend award of this contract to M&L Power Systems, Inc. in the amount of \$346,500. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.


