RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A NEW 2024 FORD F350 UTILITY TRUCK THROUGH THE MORRIS COUNTY COOPERATIVE PRICING COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Authority's existing 2008 Ford F250 pickup truck, currently used in the Liquid Division, is beyond its service life and is not repairable, and the Authority seeks to purchase a new utility truck to replace the 2010 Chevrolet utility truck, which will be transferred from the Maintenance Department to the Liquid Division for their use in the operation of the treatment plants, as more particularly detailed in the attached memo; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5) authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements for its administration; and

WHEREAS, under Res. No. 24-0722-2, the Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority Board of Commissioners approved the Authority's membership into the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council; and

WHEREAS, The Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council (MCCPC) has offered voluntary participation in a cooperative pricing system for the purchase of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, the Authority staff have obtained comparative price quotes for the same replacement maintenance truck under both the State Contract and the MCCPC from the corresponding vendor for this vehicle, where the Authority is able to purchase the 2024 Ford F350 truck with utility body and other comparable options at a cost of \$65,478.50 through the MCCPC vendor (Ciocca Ford of Flemington), which is lower than a similar truck (F250 vs. F350) at a cost of \$67,047.00 through the State Contract vendor (Winner Ford of Cherry Hill) (see the attached quotes), and we recommend to authorize and additional \$300 for documentation fee; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority has certified in writing the availability of funds for the purposes set forth in this Resolution, and the cost is affordable due to budget management in the duly adopted 2024 operating budget of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority, specifically line item: Maintenance – Vehicles (01-400-6493).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority Board of Commissioners, that the Authority hereby authorizes the purchase of a new 2024 Ford F350 utility truck (as per the attached quote) plus \$300 documentation fee from Ciocca Ford of Flemington through the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council in the amount not to exceed \$65,778.50 without further authorization, to be funded out of the Authority's FY 2024 Operating Budget, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority Board of Commissioners further authorizes, directs and empowers the Executive Director to enter into and execute the necessary contracts and documents.
