

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MODIFICATION OF

WHEREAS, The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority has an established Industrial Pretreatment Program to allow for and regulate the discharge of industrial effluent and/or groundwater via a permit program; and

WHEREAS, Roche Molecular Systems, Inc., located at 1080 Route 202 in Branchburg, New Jersey, is regulated via the Non-Domestic Wastewater Discharge Permit No. 28J; and,

WHEREAS, Roche Molecular Systems, Inc. has requested that the Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority (SRVSA) modify Non-Domestic Wastewater Discharge Permit 28J to amend the Compliance Point in Section II to incorporate a future, inactive, sampling site and provisions to activate the future sampling site and deactivate the existing sampling site via minor modification upon completion of construction; and

WHEREAS, the above-referenced industry has agreed to abide by all of the rules and regulations of the Authority concerning the discharge of non-domestic wastewater to the Authority's system; and

WHEREAS, a thirty-day Public Comment Period was held to receive written comments or to request that the SRVSA hold a non-adversarial Public Hearing. No public comments were received during the Public Comment Period, nor were there any requests for a non-adversarial Public Hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority that it hereby authorizes the issuance of modified Non-Domestic Wastewater Discharge Permit 28K for Roche Molecular Systems, Inc., located at 1080 Route 202 in Branchburg, New Jersey.





RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND THE PLANT SUPERINTENDENT TO TRAVEL TO THE CATERPILLAR FACILITY IN GRIFFIN, GA TO PERFORM AN INSPECTION ON THE NEW CATERPILLAR EMERGENCY GENERATOR SET FOR THE AUTHORITY'S STORM CONTROL PUMPING STATION RELOCATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority is in the process of installing a new emergency generator set as part of its Storm Control Pumping Station Relocation Project (SCPSRP), and where the proposed new emergency generator set needed for this project is of the same size and specification as the newly existing emergency generator set at the Storm Control Treatment Facility, which is where the proposed emergency generator set for the SCPSRP shall be co-located; and

WHEREAS, under Res. No. 23-1218-7, the Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority Board of Commissioners approved the furnishing and delivery of one (1) new Caterpillar Emergency Generator Set to Foley Power Systems, and the manufacture of said generator set is nearly completed at the Caterpillar facility in Griffin, GA and where it may necessary to send Authority representatives who are knowledgeable about the project to this facility to verify the existence of and inspect the emergency generator set if the generator is ready for shipment prior to the construction of the generator foundation at the project site, as further described in the attached memo; and

WHEREAS, if necessary, the Executive Director and the Plant Superintendent are planning to fly to Atlanta, GA and travel to the Caterpillar facility for the emergency generator set inspection, and fly back to New Jersey within the same day, with all travel-related expenses being reimbursed by the Authority.



RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE SLUDGE HAULING COSTS RELATED TO THE EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT FOR THE REPAIRS OF THE R2 INCINERATOR PRIMARY AND TERTIARY HEAT EXCHANGERS

WHEREAS, during the month of May, the Authority staff determined that there was the collection of incinerator ash in places that it should not normally be within the incinerator duct system, and where it was determined that there was a leak in the tertiary heat exchanger (THX) was the cause, and where the R2 Incinerator was taken out of service on May 24th to begin a several-day cooldown period before inspections could be made to determine the cause of the problem and to obtain price quotations for the repair, and it appears that the interior of the THX has become corroded from being in service for approximately seven (7) years, where it is necessary to repair this unit in place, and where a blown gasket at the top seal of the primary heat exchanger (PHX) became apparent just prior to the May 24th shutdown, and where the repairs to the PHX unit were performed by the same contractor at this time to minimize downtime and re-mobilization costs, and where it was necessary to conduct offsite sludge hauling and disposal to maintain the wastewater treatment plant operations, and where the offsite sludge disposal shall be funded out of a combination of the remaining funds in the FY2025 operating budget and the Authority's General Fund, and;

WHEREAS, under Res. No. 25-0623-6, which authorized the emergency procurement of the R2 Incinerator primary & tertiary heat exchangers, this resolution included a provision that the actual cost of the emergency sludge hauling would be memorialized under a separate resolution, and where the actual costs of the sludge hauling, which occurred between May 24th and June 18th is a total of \$366,965 for twenty-six (26) days of hauling, with \$19,116.00 funded out of the Authority's FY25 Operating Budget and excess costs of \$347,849 funded out of the Authority's General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority has certified in writing the offsite sludge hauling and disposal set forth in this Resolution, to be funded out of the Authority's FY 2025 Operating Budget line-item, Operations – Offsite Sludge Disposal (01-300-6328) and excess sludge hauling costs to be funded out of the Authority's General Fund, Sludge Disposal-Cake & Liquid, specifically (04-300-6328).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority, as follows:

1. The Authority affirms and authorizes the actual excess cost and payment of offsite sludge hauling and disposal expenses shall be paid through the General Fund for the amount not to exceed \$347,849 without further authorization from the Board, to be funded out of the Authority's General Fund, specifically – (04-300-6328).

2. The Authority's Executive Director, staff and consultants shall take all actions necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.



**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE
MASTER CUSTOMER AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE SOMERSET
RARITAN VALLEY SEWERAGE AUTHORITY AND PSE&G FOR PERFORMANCE
OF AN ENERGY AUDIT AND POTENTIAL INSTALLATION OF ENERGY
EFFICIENT MEASURES**

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2023, The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority (SRVSA) Board adopted Resolution No. 23-0828-7 authorizing the execution of the Master Customer Agreement with PSE&G for an energy audit to be performed at no cost to SRVSA, with the potential (subject to separate approval) for the design, procurement and installation of energy efficient measures, with funding advanced by PSE&G upon completion of certain conditions for approved construction and engineering costs, having a five year repayment period; and

WHEREAS, the energy audit is the primary mechanism for PSE&G to identify energy efficient measures that could be taken to systems such as lighting, HVAC, building envelope, motor control and others that are appropriate and cost effective that meet the requirements of the aforementioned program; and

WHEREAS, PSE&G has recently completed its energy audit and it is currently under review by SRVSA staff; and

WHEREAS, if the SRVSA desires to proceed, a separate Resolution will be required to authorize the execution of the Limited Notice to Proceed so that PSE&G can prepare bid-ready construction documents for SRVSA to utilize in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, in the event a construction contract has been awarded to the lowest responsible bidder (subject to PSE&G review and approval of the approved project costs) a separate Resolution of the Board will be necessary in order to approve the Customer Repayment Agreement, in order for PSE&G to fund the approved project costs; and

WHEREAS, in the event SRVSA desires to proceed with energy efficient measures at upon completion PSE&G's financial commitment to advance funds to SRVSA in three stages to fund the installation and engineering costs of the energy efficiency measures when certain conditions are satisfied, consisting of 30% of the costs upon execution of the construction contract (Stage 1) 50% in a series of progress payments commencing with the installation process (Stage 2) and the final 20% upon final completion (Stage 3), followed by SRVSA's repayment to PSE&G of its share of the engineering and energy efficiency measure costs by means of a charge to SRVSA's monthly utility bill over a period of five years; and

WHEREAS, PSE&G has proposed certain amendments to the Master Customer Agreement and Limited Notice to Proceed that primarily focus on union requirements and the use of project labor agreements if the cost of the project equals or exceeds \$5 million for a "public works project" as defined by N.J.S.A. 52:38-2, as well as proposed amendments to the form of Customer Repayment

Agreement that pertain to notice requirements and repayment of unpaid balances due to PSE&G in the event of the sale of the facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority Board of Commissioners as follows:

- (1) The Executive Director is authorized to execute the First Amendment to the Master Customer Agreement, which also attaches the revised proposed forms of Limited Notice to Proceed and Customer Repayment Agreement as Exhibits.
- (2) Execution of the Limited Notice to Proceed and Customer Repayment Agreement shall not occur at this time and shall require separate approvals of the SRVSA Board.
- (3) The Executive Director, staff and consultants are authorized to take all appropriate actions to effectuate this Resolution.
- (4) This Resolution shall take effect immediately.







RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF THE INSPECTION AND CLEANING OF THE AUTHORITY'S INVERTED SIPHON PIPES BY MAGNUM VAC SERVICES THROUGH THE SOMERSET COUNTY COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM

WHEREAS, approximately every five (5) years the Authority performs periodic internal TV inspection and high-pressure jetting cleaning of the Authority's existing three (3) sets of inverted siphons crossing the Raritan River along the 1958 Main Interceptor and the 2005 Relief Interceptor Sewer pipelines, and where under the Somerset County Cooperative Pricing System (Co-Op), the Authority staff have obtained a price quote from Magnum Vac Services (vendor) for this service for the total amount of \$175,240, and where the Authority staff has obtained a quote of approximately \$195,000 from Standard Pipe Services, the vendor who performed this work in 2020, and where in 2020 this work was performed at a cost of \$125,000, where the quoted price from Magnum Vac Services represents an 11.27% savings below the quote from Standard Pipe Services, (as more particularly described in the attached memo); and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5) authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements for its administration; and

WHEREAS, the Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority Board of Commissioners has previously approved the Authority's membership into the Somerset County Cooperative Pricing System; and

WHEREAS, The Somerset County Cooperative Pricing System has offered voluntary participation in a cooperative pricing system for the purchase of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority has certified in writing the availability of funds for the purposes set forth in this Resolution, and the cost is provided for in the duly adopted budget of The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority, FY 2025 Operating Budget line-item Maintenance – Interceptor System (01-400-6461).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that The Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority Board of Commissioners further authorizes, directs and empowers the Executive Director to enter into and execute the necessary contracts and documents.
